David M. Hart is Professor and Director of the Center for Science, Technology, and Innovation Policy at the Schar School of Policy and Government at George Mason University. Prof. Hart is a senior fellow on clean energy innovation policy at the Information Technology and Innovation Foundation, where he also is a member of the board of directors, and a non-resident senior fellow in the Metropolitan Policy Program at the Brookings Institution. Professor Hart served as Senior Associate Dean in 2013-2015 and as assistant director for innovation policy, with a focus on advanced manufacturing, at the Office of Science and Technology Policy, Executive Office of the President, in 2011-2012. Hart's books include *Unlocking Energy Innovation* (MIT Press, co-authored with Richard K. Lester), *The Emergence of Entrepreneurship Policy* (Cambridge University Press), and *Forged Consensus: Science, Technology, and Economic Policy in the U.S., 1929-1953* (Princeton University Press).
